Synergy Career Ignite to graduate first class

HOLLY HILL — The inaugural class of a new program to help long-term unemployed and under-employed workers launch careers in medical billing and coding is set to graduate Thursday.

The Synergy Career Ignite program is a partnership of CareerSource Flagler Volusia, the regional workforce development board, and Synergy Billing, a growing Daytona Beach company that provides medical billing and coding services to community health centers across the country. Thirteen students who took part in the four-month program will graduate in a ceremony from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. at The Market in Holly Hill, on the corner of Riverside Drive and Second Street, where the Synergy Billing Academy is located. The event is open to the public.
